

## FILE PREP CHECKLIST: BIG PRINTS

To make the most of ScitexVision Idanit Novo TurboPrint technology, here's a failsafe checklist to preparing your softcopy files to maximise colour and resolution quality.

### ■ **IMAGE SIZE**

Fix the document size to the ACTUAL dimensions. For example, if the print is required to be 2 meters by 1 meter, set to say 2m x 1 m on your document in your application.

### ■ **RESOLUTION**

Set your files to 60 dpi.

Or if you need better resolution scanning, Turbo Print can support your scanning requirements (up to 40 bit high resolution scanning) at \$20 per scan. Simply send us your transparency or photograph image.

### ■ **COLOURS**

If you are saving a photoshop format file, please adjust your colour modes to CMYK.

### ■ **TEXT**

Convert all text and copy to paths if possible. This minimises the need to supply us fonts and any unnecessary errors.

### ■ **FORMATS**

For ease of sending by email, the best format to send us is in jpegs or editable eps (for vector based artwork)

### ■ **DRAFTS**

To be extra sure, always send us a smaller, lower resolution draft in jpeg format for us to refer to as a guide to check accuracy. You may also send us prior to getting the job done so that we can advise a more thorough file preparation method.
